This tour is conducted on our 1000 acres property known as the Fresh Water Creek area in the Stann Creek District. Your horse will be waiting for you to walk you through our coffee plantation as you get consumed with the sweet fragrance of the flowers. Suddenly, you find yourself riding through teak, cedar, mahogany, fruit, papaya, and pineapples. Huge cedar, gumbo limbo trees and other undergrowth which offer homes to a variety of tropical birds. The horses are well trained, and they are led by a tour guide who is an experienced horse wrangler. As you take a break in the middle of the forest, you will be complemented with a swim in the beautiful Fresh Water Creek.
