The Belize Zoo is a showcase of the country's native animals. It began as a small backyard zoo in 1983, and today, the zoo covers 29 acres and contains 170 animals from 45 species. The zoo provides conservation, protection, and education about these beautiful creatures.

A visit to the Belize zoo is a great way to discover native animals such as jaguars, ocelots, tapirs, and howler monkeys, and beautiful native birds like the toucan and scarlet macaw.
